Year 3/4: Harry B: Always doing the right thing.

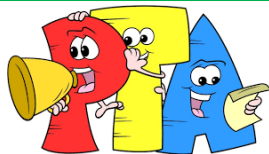
Year 5/6: Alec: Showing kindness to classmates.
